## **Frequently Asked Questions**

### **1. How do I access the scholarship application?**

### **2. Do I have to have great grades to apply for a Mapleton Education Foundation Scholarship?**

Grades are only one consideration in a number of different criteria the Mapleton Education Foundation Scholarship Committee considers when reviewing scholarship applications. The committee highly recommends that all students apply and that students do not let their grades be a determining factor in their decision to apply for a scholarship.

### **3. What are the steps of the scholarship application process?**

- 1) Students should complete the scholarship application.
- 2) Double check to make sure all required fields are filled out properly and directions were followed.
- 3) Make sure to turn your application in by the deadline set by your individual post secondary coach **or** to the Welcome Center by March 11, 2010.
- 4) The Mapleton Education Foundation Scholarship Committee will review all applications and narrow down the applicants for the interview round.
- 5) Applicants will be notified by letter if they received an interview.
- 6) A committee of 3 to 5 people will conduct a 10 minute interview with all qualifying applicants.
- 7) Applicants will be notified by letter of the scholarship status.
- 8) Scholarship winners have one year to activate their scholarship.
- 9) Scholarship winners will be invited to attend a scholarship breakfast on May 19<sup>th</sup>.

### **4. Can I apply for more than one scholarship?**

Yes. The Board highly encourages students to apply for as many scholarships as they can that fit their focus and criteria. However, students are eligible to receive only one scholarship. The scholarship awarded is the highest of the two received.

**5. Do I have to be attending a college or university to receive a scholarship?**

No. Scholarships are awarded to students attending any accredited post secondary program.
